Saturday, 3/18/17: MCA Elementary Schools Championship at Baltimore Poly-Western HS

There were 58 players in the Novice section. Two of our former Beach players, Lyndsey Dobson and Joseph Dunn, now 6th graders, competed in the MS/HS section for Windy Hill Middle.
